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Chapter I. Organisation.

Article 1. Definition of the event.

The event SPA SIX HOURS 2023 has the status of International Event and consists of the following series:

the F.I.A. International Sporting Code prescriptions in compliance with the 2023 prescriptions of the RACB Sport.

The Clerk of the Course must inflict the penalties set out in the sporting regulations. For all cases not provided in the regulations, the will hand over a report to the Panel of the Stewards of the Meeting, that will apply the regulations provided by the International Sporting Code (article 12) or National Sporting Code.

- the amount of the Right to Protest fixed by RACB Sport : € 500,00

Right of Appeal :

- the amount of the National Right of Appeal is (RACB Sport) : € 2.000,00

- the amount of the International Right of Appeal is (FIA) : € 6.000,00
