Competitor Joining Instructions Specific to Motor Racing Legends Grids



Introduction

We thank you for supporting the Donington Historic Festival, and hope you have a very enjoyable time. We have spelt out below some simple instructions regarding paddock access and vehicle parking.

Please read these joining instructions very carefully to ensure you understand how to get into the event and to avoid any confusion on arrival.

The public will not be admitted to the event. However, we ask all competitors to please still arrange their paddock set-up in such a way as to give the best display of race-cars.

Final Instructions

The Final Instructions contain much information that you will need for this meeting. It is essential that everyone in your team has read them.

Driver Sign-On & Scrutineering

All drivers **MUST** complete the electronic self-declaration via the link in the Final Instructions by 5.00pm on Friday 30th April.

Drivers Briefings

All drivers **MUST** complete the electronic Drivers Briefing via the link in the Final Instructions. This link will only be active 48 Hours before the meeting starts.

Please be aware that anyone failing to complete the Drivers Briefing in advance **WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RACE!**

Paddock Opening Times Friday 30th April:

Paddock 1 & Garages: (RAC Pall Mall Cup) access from 18.00 on Friday

Paddock 2 & 3 (all other grids): access from 14.00 on Friday

Detailed Paddock access times for the weekend are listed in the Final Instructions.

Paddock Access

On approach to the Paddock Entrance, <u>all</u> vehicles will be directed around to the 'Tarmac Lake'. No vehicles will be admitted via the Paddock Gate during the meeting. On first arrival, drivers of all vehicles must report to the Reception Cabin situated on the Tarmac Lake to register. Appropriate vehicles will be given a Vehicle Paddock Pass for the relevant paddock and will then be escorted into the Paddock by the Paddock Parking Team. All Vehicle Passes will be marked with the vehicle's registration number and will be invalidated if transferred to another vehicle.

Any road cars and other non-essential vehicles will be parked in the Competitors Car Park on the Tarmac Lake throughout the meeting. It is a very short walk into the paddock from here. Please be

aware that any road cars that may have been granted temporary access on Friday for setting up will not be re-admitted to the paddock during the weekend.

Any vehicles arriving prior to the Paddock opening times on Friday will be held on the Tarmac Lake until their Paddock is available.

Entry Tickets

Access tickets will be in the form of e-tickets which will be emailed to each Entrant directly by MSVR. Please distribute these tickets to your team members and preparers. All tickets will be scanned on entry and on exit.

Vehicle Passes

Vehicle passes will only be distributed on arrival at the circuit (see above). No vehicle passes will be sent out in advance.

Motorhome Parking

Motorhomes will only be permitted in the general race paddocks if they are: <u>less than 6m in overall length</u>; and are clearly acting as a support vehicle to a race car. Any other motorhomes will be parked in the dedicated Motorhome Parking area in Paddock 3. Please assume that no power is available on site.

Trailer Parking

All trailers are to be parked in the dedicated secure trailer parking area on the Tarmac Lake. The Paddock Parking Team will be able to assist in removing trailers. Space is always at a premium and we ask that you do all you can to help in this matter by parking your trailer away from the main paddock.

MRL Hospitality

We will be offering full MRL hospitality on the day of your race as follows:

Morning Brunch from 8.00am
Take-away lunch platter 12.00 – 3.00pm
Afternoon Tea & cakes from 3.00pm onwards

Access to the hospitality is via wristband and lunch ticket. Please collect these on arrival from the MRL office in Paddock 2.

We have arranged for a large, covered seating area for your use. This will have open sides in accordance with current Covid regulations.

Podiums

There will be a Covid-compliant Podium and trophy presentation after every race. This will take place in the Scrutineering Bay area.

Collection of MRL Class Awards

Motor Racing Legends will be awarding trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in Class in all of our grids, where relevant. These awards will be available to collect 30 minutes after your race from the MRL Office in Paddock 2 (see Paddock Plan). Please do not forget to come and collect your trophies and prizes – you will regret it, especially if you are thirsty! There will be no formal prize-giving due to Covid restrictions.
