#### **General Information**

#### **Timetable**

#### **Paddock Access**

The event will be run out of the Wing and the International Paddock. Access to the paddock will be from 4pm on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October.

#### **Motorhomes**

Motorhomes are permitted in the paddock overnight on the Saturday night. Please note that there will be no lavatory or showers available overnight so teams will need to be self-sufficient in this regard. Tents are not allowed nor campervans without their own self-contained facilities. There will be limited toilet facilities for truck drivers staying in sleeper cabs overnight and no showers will be available.

#### **Parking**

The International Paddock can become very crowded. We will aim to park road cars and trailers immediately outside the paddock where necessary.

#### **Garages**

Garages will be available to all competitors or you can run out of your truck/trailer in the paddock if you prefer. Cars and teams will be spaced in adherence to current MSUK rules relating to Covid-19 social distancing.

#### **Catering/Hospitality**

We have use of Hall 5 in the Wing throughout the day on Sunday. A cafeteria service will be available in Hall 5 to purchase meals and refreshments. It will also provide

Under current MSUK guidance, it will be mandatory to wear face mask at all times on site, unless wearing a crash helmet. This includes the pit lane, garages, paddock areas and Hall 5.

### **Three-Hour Race – Specific FAQs**

- Each car should have two or three drivers.
- We encourage entries to form teams of three cars, as per the regulations. However, it is absolutely NOT necessary to be in a team to enter.
- Refuelling is mandatory in the three-hour race. Please read the race regulations thoroughly in this regard. Refuelling will take place in the pit lane during the race. Each stop must be for a minimum of five minutes to ensure safety is maintained at all times. Teams must only use a dry-break system (such as Tuff Jugs) for refuelling. Cans, funnels or spouts will NOT be permitted. Tuff Jugs and fuel can be ordered from Sunoco using the form on our website
