



Joining Instructions

Thank you for supporting the Motor Racing Legends Silverstone GP meeting. This document details further information about the event plus links to the on-line drivers sign on. The Joining Instructions are supplemental to the Final Instructions and in the event of a conflict between this document and the Final Instructions, then the Final Instructions take precedence.

DRIVER SIGN-ON ONLINE

Prior to the event, every driver MUST complete the MSVR on-line driver signing-on no less than 24 hours prior to their first session on track.

Please access the Driver Declaration Form via this link. Please have photographs of the back and front of your race license ready to upload.

TICKETS

E-entry tickets for competitors, personnel etc will be emailed directly to the Entrant's email address in advance of the meeting. They can be printed off or saved to a smart phone. Pall Mall Cup teams will receive seven tickets; two-driver grids will receive five tickets per entry; single-driver grids will receive four tickets.

PADDOCK ACCESS

Access to the International Paddock (the Wing) will be via the Main Gate. The Link road will be open.

Due to extremely limited space within the paddock, only valid support vehicles will be permitted within the paddock. Paddock vehicle passes will be issued to appropriate vehicles on arrival at the paddock gate at the Wing. Access will be entirely at the discretion of the MRL Paddock Team. Please respect their decisions.

All competitor and team road cars will be parked in the compound towards Race Control. If the compound is full, additional vehicles are required to park in the overflow parking outside the Hilton Hotel.

Overflow and public parking will be in the car parks outside the Hilton Hotel. 24 Hour pedestrian access to the paddock will be available via the link bridge from the Hilton Hotel. This will be open until 19.00hrs on Sunday evening. Access via the link bridge will only be possible with an e-ticket.

As last year, trailer parking is on the inside of Stowe corner at the Stowe Lake area.

ACCESS TIMES

If you are Testing, access is from **17:00hrs on Thursday 19th October**.

Race Weekend access to the Silverstone International Paddock is available from **13.00hrs on Friday 20th October**. The paddock will be closed to vehicles from 20.00hrs each night. It will re-open from 07.00hrs each morning.

MOTORHOMES

Motorhomes are permitted to stay overnight in the Paddock on Friday (20th) and Saturday (21st) nights. An area of the paddock is reserved for competitor motorhomes. There are electric hook ups available. Please make us aware that you are bringing a motorhome and email steph@motorracinglegends.com detailing the name of the team and the size of the vehicle.

GARAGES

Garages are reserved for the MRL grids and GT Allcomers Challenge grid. A garage plan will be issued ahead of the meeting and must be strictly adhered to. If you are testing and have booked a garage you will not have to move. If you have any specific requests you must inform Gillian before Tuesday 17th October (gillian@motorracinglegends.com) Please note that garages will be shared; please co-operate with your fellow occupants with regards parking arrangements.

GARAGE ACCESS

The pit lane will be live at all times during the event and must NOT be used to access the Assembly Area. To access the Assembly Area in the paddock from the Garages, all cars must only use the rear garage doors and access the assembly area through the paddock side of the garage. Therefore, it is essential that you leave room for race cars to pass through behind your allocated garage.

EVENT OFFICE

The Motor Racing Legend Events Office will be situated upstairs adjacent to Hall 3.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

There will be mandatory Drivers Briefings for all grids to be held in Media Rooms 2 & 3 on the first floor of Hall 3 entrance (top of stairs turn right). The schedule is as follows;

SCRUTINEERING SAFETY CHECKS

In addition to the pre-event on-line self-declaration, and in line with Motorsport UK guidance, at least 25% of vehicles will be physically inspected by a Motorsport UK scrutineer during the meeting. These cars will be selected at random; the scrutineering team will work through the paddock to the various grid area at the following times. Please make a note of what time the scrutineering team will visit your garage or paddock area and ensure that you are ready to be checked, car and driver race kit.

TYRES

HP Tyres look forward to providing your race tyres for the weekend but please order your required tyres for MRL Silverstone event **before 5pm on Thursday 19th October**. Please also note that there will be no payment facilities at the circuit and no paperwork handover. The service trucks will only be carrying a minimal quantity of tyres so it is imperative that all tyres are **ordered and paid for prior** to the race weekend to avoid disappointment.

FUEL

Anglo American Oil Company will be present at the MRL Silverstone GP meeting pumping both the leaded 101 octane R5SR+, the leaded 105 octane R6SR, and the unleaded oxygenated 102 octane Sunoco FR. You do not need to pre-book any of these fuels when bought by the litre. However, if you would like them to

bring any other Sunoco race fuels in drums, or Driven oils, to the meeting please call their office on 01929 551557 latest by Monday 16th to pre-book.

REFUELLING REGIME

The three-hour Royal Automobile Club Pall Mall Cup will feature in-race refuelling. It is imperative that all teams in this race fully understand the refuelling regulations as laid out in the race regulations. Garage doors to remain shut during refuelling. Please contact us if anything is at all unclear.

AWARDS and PODIUMS

For all races, there will be podium presentations for the first three cars in each race to be presented on the podium in the paddock, adjacent to Race Control, immediately after each race. In addition, for all MRL grids there will be a presentation of Class Awards in Hall 3 within 30 minutes of the end of each race.

MRL Royal Automobile Club Pall Mall Cup. There will be a drinks party to celebrate the conclusion of the race and prize giving in Hall 3 after the race on Saturday. All MRL drivers are welcome.

MRL HOSPITALITY

Hospitality for the MRL grids will be in Hall 3 above the garages. Access will be via wristband to be issued at the MRL desk at the entrance of Hall 3.

Hot drinks will be available in the mornings, lunches will be served from noon until 15:00 both days.

Team personnel and the general public without hospitality wristbands will be able to purchase food and drinks from Silverstone Catering in Hall 5.
