DRIVER SIGN-ON ONLINE

Prior to the event, every driver MUST complete the MSVR on-line driver signing-on no less than 24 hours prior to their first session on track.

TICKETS

For this year each individual team member will need an Electronic Pass. Team passes will be sent to each Entrant who will then need to distribute to individual team members.

To access the Electronic Passes, each individual must download the Silverstone Ticket App to your smart phone:

The Entrant must log on with the same email address that was given to us for the Entrant. Please let us know if you need the system to use a different address. Paddock Access

Please note that the meeting will be run from the [National Paddock](#).

You will separately be sent a vehicle pass to print off and present to the paddock managers to gain access to the paddock area. There are separate passes for the MRL Paddock and the HRDC Paddock.

Access to the main paddock will be restricted to HGVs, and smaller transporters. There is to be no parking immediately behind the garages as access to the rear of the garages will be required at all times. Please help us to keep the paddock tidy and park road cars, vans etc in the Competitor parking. Please park Car trailers and support vehicles that are not required on the Copse runway. We are trying to create a nice atmosphere in the paddock so your assistance to keep it tidy is hugely appreciated. Access will be entirely at the discretion of the MRL Paddock Team. Please respect their decisions.

All competitor and team road cars will be parked in the Paddock Diner Car Park. If this area is full please use the overflow car park by the Medical Centre.

Access Times

If you are Testing, access is from **19:00hrs on Thursday 17th October**. Upon arrival at Silverstone you will be held in Car Park 49 until paddock opens.

The paddock will close at 21.00hrs on Thursday 17th October.

Thereafter the paddock will open at 07.00hrs until 22.00hrs Friday 18th until Sunday 20th.

Motorhomes

An area of the paddock is reserved for competitor motorhomes. Motorhomes are permitted to stay overnight in the Paddock on Thursday (17th), Friday (18th) and Saturday (20th) nights. Electric hook ups available. Once full, overflow Motorhome parking is on the Copse Runway, with no power availability.

Garages

Garages are reserved for the MRL grids, there is no need to book, all entrants will be allocated with a garage.

The garage plan will be posted on the MRL Silverstone GP meeting page of [MRL Silverstone Event Page](#) on Tuesday 15th October. If you are testing and have booked a garage you can remain in place for the weekend, providing you are in your allocated garage. If you have any specific requests you must inform Gillian before Friday 11th October. (gillian@motorracinglegends.com) Please note that garages will be shared; please co-operate with your fellow occupants with regards parking arrangements.

GARAGE ACCESS

The pit lane will be live at all times during the event and must NOT be used to access the Assembly Area. To access the Assembly Area in the paddock from the Garages, all cars must only use the rear garage doors and access the assembly area through the paddock side of the garage. Therefore no vehicles will be permitted to park immediately behind the garages.

EVENT OFFICE

The Motor Racing Legend Events Office will be located in the MRL hospitality tent in the paddock.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

There will be mandatory Drivers Briefings for all MRL grids. These will be held in the MRL Hospitality in the centre of the paddock.

SCRUTINEERING SAFETY CHECKS

In addition to the pre-event on-line self-declaration, and in line with Motorsport UK guidance, at least 25% of vehicles will be physically inspected by a Motorsport UK scrutineer during the meeting for all MRL grids bar GT3 Legends & HRDC. Cars will be selected at random; the scrutineering team will work through the paddock to the various grid area at the following times. Please make a note of what time the scrutineering team will visit your garage or paddock area and ensure that you are ready to be checked, car and driver race kit.

All GT3 Legends cars must be scrutineered. Cars will be scrutineered in situ from 08.00hrs on Saturday 18th. It is hoped to have scrutineering available on Friday afternoon – further details to follow. All GT3 Legends cars must also be presented to the GT3 Legends Eligibility Scrutineer in the Scrutineering bay to be weighed prior to the race on Saturday 19th.

TYRES

HP Tyres look forward to providing your race tyres for the weekend but please order your required tyres for MRL Silverstone event **before 5pm on Thursday 19th October**. Please also note that there will be no payment facilities at the circuit and no paperwork handover. The service trucks will only be carrying a minimal quantity of tyres so it is imperative that all tyres are **ordered and paid for prior** to the race weekend to avoid disappointment.

FUEL

As usual Anglo American Oil Company (Sunoco race fuels) will be on site from Friday morning pumping the R5SR+, the R6SR and Sunoco FR which you can buy by the litre and no need to pre-order. However, if you need any other Sunoco race fuels you need to pre-order them by calling their office on 01929 551557 latest by Tuesday the 15th October.

REFUELLING REGIME

The three-hour Royal Automobile Club Pall Mall Cup will feature in-race refuelling. It is imperative that all teams in this race fully understand the refuelling regulations as laid out in the race regulations. Garage doors to remain shut during refuelling. Please contact us if anything is at all unclear.

AWARDS and PODIUMS

For all races, there will be podium presentations for the first three cars in each race to be presented on the podium in the paddock, adjacent to Race Control, immediately after each race.

In addition, for all MRL grids there will be a presentation of Class Awards in the Motor Racing Legends Hospitality Tent within 30 minutes of the end of each race.

There will be a party open to all MRL participants and guests to celebrate the conclusion of the Pall Mall Cup and prize giving in the BRDC Clubhouse on Saturday evening. The Clubhouse will be open for race viewing from 17.000hrs. Party access wristbands will be available from the MRL Hospitality through the day.
