Joining Instructions

With the Silverstone Festival fast approaching, we'd like to share with you some essential information about the meeting that will help ensure you have the most enjoyable experience at the event. These details relate specifically to the Motor Racing Legends grids and to the National Paddock from which we will be based. Please read them carefully to avoid unnecessary frustration on arrival.

In particular – please note the new arrangements for Electronic Passes for this event.

Driver Self-Declaration

All drivers should by now have been emailed with a link to the on-line self-declaration form. Please complete this as soon as possible. If you are in multiple races across the weekend then please ensure you are signed on for every race that you have entered.

Access Times Pre-Event

As per Page 5 of the Competitor Guide:

11:00 – 20:00 PRE-BOOKED Multicar Preparers for set-up at rear of paddocks only.
No tail lifts to be dropped in National Paddock until 19:00.

11:00 – 20:00 PRE-BOOKED Competitor Motorhome & Camping opens in Pink Zone 32 and Red Zone 24

19:00 – 20:00 Pit Garages available for dropping off race cars and tools/ spares etc

20:00 STRICTLY no access to venue for setup after 20:00

THURSDAY 24 AUGUST

07:00 Paddock and Pit Garage access for further set-up and pre-booked testing

08:00 Testing sign-on opens

09:00 – 17:00 Testing

20:00 STRICTLY no access to venue for setup after 20:00

Access Tickets

For this year each individual team member will need an Electronic Pass and a Team Wristband. Each MRL Entry will receive seven Electronic Passes and Team Wristbands.

The **Electronic Passes** will gain you access to the venue and will be sent to you via a dedicated app in advance of arriving. The tickets will allow you access every day, Wednesday through to Sunday.

Your **TEAM wristbands** are still required for access to the pit lane during your sessions, both race controls and the competitor motorhome areas.

To access the Electronic Passes, you must download the Silverstone Ticket App to your smart phone:

You must log on with the same email address that was given to us for the Entrant. Please let us know if you need the system to use a different address.

Within the App the Entrant can forward passes on to other team members, who must also have downloaded the Silverstone Ticket App. See [Silverstone Ticket App Guide](#) for more information.

Team Wristbands for all Motor Racing Legends grids will be available to collect from the 'Customer Corner' Welcome Centre via Entrance 5 on Wednesday and Thursday. There will be a pack in the name of the race Entrant containing all wristbands and vehicle passes for that entry. If you have entered multiple races, then there will be multiple packs to collect. You will be able to leave passes for late-arriving team members at the 'Customer Corner'. The Customer Corner is located adjacent to the main entrance barrier. Please study the map on page 6 of the Competitor Guide for set up access routes.

The Motor Racing Legends desk within Customer Corner will be open from 11.00 – 20.00 on Wednesday and 07.30 – 20.00 on Thursday. Customer Corner will also be open on each event day.

Vehicle Passes

Each MRL Entry will receive 2 Vehicle set up passes for paddock access on Wednesday and Thursday to drop off your race car into pit garages, and 2 Competitor parking passes for parking Friday to Sunday in Pink Zone 35.

Vehicle Passes will be in the pack for collection from Customer Corner, as above.

Garage Allocation & Multicar Preparer Spaces

Garage Allocation and Multicar Preparer slots are only available to teams who have already pre-booked spaces.

The Garage Allocation Plan will show all teams that have requested space.

Support vehicles will not be permitted in front of the garages.

Scrutineering

All cars for MRL grids will be scrutineered in the Scrutineering Bay in the National Paddock.

Scrutineering will be from 14.00 – 19.00 on Thursday and also on Friday morning.

Friday morning will be especially busy, so we recommend getting your car scrutineered on Thursday.

Drivers Briefings

Mandatory Drivers Briefings will be held for all MRL grids on Friday morning. Timings are as per the Final Instructions, but please note that briefings for the Motor Racing Legends grids will be held in the MRL Hospitality facility (not the Apex Suite)

MRL Hospitality

Our hospitality facility will be at the Race Control-end of the National paddock, as per the 'blue' map on page 3 of the Competitor Guide.

Our facility will be open from 07.30 on Friday morning. Please make a point to collect your hospitality passes from the welcome desk inside our hospitality as soon as you can on Friday morning.

Each driver will receive two hospitality wristbands; two lunch tickets for Friday and two lunch tickets for the day of your race.

Lunch will be served between 12.00 and 14.30 each day.

Podiums

Podiums will be held immediately after each race. The podium will be situated outside our Hospitality.

MRL Prize-Givings

We will hold our post-race prize-givings in the Motor Racing Legends Hospitality right after each race. We will be on a tight timetable both race days so please help us, and our sponsors, by arriving promptly after your race has finished.
