## **SIGN-ON**

Participants must sign-on in the Motor Racing Legends hospitality tent in the center of the National Paddock and present their race license. Please note the sign-on at the time appropriate to your group as per the timetable above. You will be issued with a wrist band appropriate to the session for which you are booked on and a coloured sticker to put on the race car window which will denote to the pit lane marshalls that you are in the correct session.

## **PASSENGERS**

Passengers are not allowed to accompany drivers on-track unless they are an accredited ARDS instructor. Licenses of accredited instructors must be presented at sign-on.

## **EQUIPMENT**

All drivers must wear full race kit as appropriate to the race meeting including – in date helmet /race overalls / fire proof gloves and boots.

## **SECOND DRIVERS**

If you wish to share your session with a second driver, they must sign an indemnity form, present their license and will be issued with a wrist band. Second drivers can only participate with permission of the entrant driver. If a driver has booked more than one car into the test, the second driver cannot be on-track at the same time as the lead driver.

## **PADDOCK ACCESS**

Access to the main paddock will be restricted to HGVs, and smaller transporters. There is to be no parking immediately behind the garages as access to the rear of the garages will be required at all times. Please help us to keep the paddock tidy and park road cars, vans etc in the Competitor parking.

Please park Car trailers and support vehicles that are not required on the Bakersfield tarmac behind Sunoco and HP Tyres. We are trying to create a nice atmosphere in the paddock so your assistance to keep it tidy is hugely appreciated. Access will be entirely at the discretion of the MRL Paddock Team. Please respect their decisions.

All competitor and team road cars will be parked in the Paddock Diner Car Park.

## **TICKETS**

You do will not require an entrance ticket to access the venue on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October but you will require the relevant vehicle pass (as above).

## **FOOD AND DRINK**

The Pit Stop Diner will be open from 08.00 hrs till 14.00 hrs for breakfast and lunch.

The Coffee Box will be available from 08.00 hrs till 15.00 hrs.

## **ACCESS TIMES**

Access is from **19:00hrs on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October** for Test Day participants only. Upon arrival at Silverstone you will be held in Car Park 49 until paddock opens.

The paddock will close at 21.00hrs on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October.

Thereafter the paddock will open at 07.00hrs until 22.00hrs Friday 18<sup>th</sup> until Sunday 20<sup>th</sup>.

### **MOTORHOMES**

An area of the paddock is reserved for competitor motorhomes. Motorhomes are permitted to stay overnight in the Paddock on Thursday (17<sup>th</sup>), Friday (18<sup>th</sup>) and Saturday (20<sup>th</sup>) nights. Electric hook ups available. Once full, overflow Motorhome parking is on the Copse Runway, with no power availability.
